ORGANIZATION SUMMARY

Continuing our housing programs and wrap-around services in a targeted 12-block area, we have created a total of 137 affordable homes and apartments, and we work with other neighborhood stakeholders to undertake community development projects and services that continue to enrich the lives of the Southeast Chicago area.

JOB SUMMARY

Claretian Associates is searching for a part-time Youth Coordinator to manage and oversee signature youth programs including U.N.I.T.Y squad (United Network influencing the transformation of youth) program and One Summer Chicago youth employment. This position will be responsible for program activities ensures a safe, healthy, educational, and robust social environment for young people between 13-18 years of age. In addition, this position with work closely with South Chicago Neighborhood Network (SCNN) in creating a trauma inform community with the emphasis on youth.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Designing and implementing, and or maintaining youth programs by being responsible for day to day operation; which includes recruitment, and building relationship within schools administrations
- Plan weekly and monthly lesson plans that align with the UNITY squad 5 core curriculum (must meet with youth twice a week in person)

- Build relationships with families to promote social and emotional growth, by conducting parent's monthly check with parents or guardians.
- Participate in the assessment of program activities, including data collection, record-keeping, and grant reporting
- Develop curriculum for One Summer Chicago summer institute, attend all One Summer Chicago training and workshops, Co facilitates summer program
- Assist in organizing, outreach, and promoting network events
- Filing and organizing network files and materials
- Attend professional development workshops to enhance skills
- Works with community groups, business organizations, and sister agencies in identifying and developing new or expanded educational, cultural, and recreational programs and services for youth in a designated community area
- Participates in the development of specifications for Requests for Proposals (RFPs) and work plans
- 25 hours per week. Flex schedule on Monday, Wednesday, Fridays and Saturdays (set program schedule already Tuesday and Thursday 2 pm-6 pm)

- Associate degree in education, social work, human services, or a related field; supplemented by more than two (2) years of directly-related experience; or an equivalent combination of education, certification, training, and/or experience. Must have a youth-focused background such as (mentoring, afterschool program, program coach, etc.)
- Must be able to pass a background Check
- Must be CPR and First Aid certified
- Bilingual abilities are a plus.
- Must be skilled in Microsoft Office (Word, Excel, PowerPoint, etc.)
- Excellent communication and organizational skills
- Ability to work in a variety of settings with culturally diverse families and communities and have the ability to be culturally sensitive and appropriate
- Ability to establish and maintain effective and cooperative working relationships with those contacted in the course of work
- Ability to regularly attend work and arrive punctually for designated work schedule
